

## Support the Quick Implementation of PPM with Project Data

The main way that project managers can support your company in implementing strategic project portfolio management (PPM) is providing accurate and up to date information about your projects to be imported into Meisterplan. This will enable management to make better and faster decisions to ensure the success of your projects. The good news is that providing this project data will not require a lot of extra time and effort, because you only need to provide basic information about each project.

## **Project Data Check List**

- Ask the Portfolio Coordinator:
  - What file format should be used for the project data?
  - What format should be used for dates (e.g., MM/DD/YY)?
  - What unit should be used for employee workload (person days, hours or full-time equivalent (FTE)?
- Provide the following project data for each project:
  - Project Name
  - Project Start Date
  - Project End Date
  - Assigned resources and/or roles
  - Current project status
  - The expected workload for each assigned role and resource
  - Any custom information as directed by the Portfolio Coordinator
